In November 2013, CCRNR announced that it had launched a project called the Nurse Practitioner Practice Analysis in order to analyse nurse practitioner practice across Canada. The Nurse Practitioner Practice Analysis will provide a comprehensive description of NP practice in Canada, which will inform future decisions about entry-to-practice exams and permit CCRNR members to develop consistent requirements for licensure or registration across the country.
