NP Practice Analysis Validation Survey is Live

We are excited to announce that the Nurse Practitioner (NP) practice analysis validation survey is now live!

If you are an NP, you should have received an email from your provincial or territorial regulator with a link to the survey and instructions on how to complete it. Haven't seen the email? Please check your spam or junk folder. The email should be titled "We need your input to validate NP practice analysis." [Contact your regulator](#) if you still cannot find the email.

Completing the survey should take about 30 minutes. Your input will contribute to the NP profession in Canada and is vital to ensuring that future NP candidates have an entry-to-practice exam that assesses the skills, knowledge, and judgment required to provide advanced nursing care to clients.

The survey is anonymous and confidential, and it is facilitated by Measure Learning Inc. Nursing regulators will not collect any of the data provided; results will be viewed in aggregate only.

If you are an employer or healthcare system partner, please encourage your NP colleagues and contacts to complete the survey.

We have not included the survey link in this newsletter as it is important that NPs use the link in the email sent by their regulator.
